

Eligibility Requirements for Angus Foundation Scholarships

- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or must be enrolled in an accredited institution (junior college, trade school, or four-year college/university) for the fall term in which the scholarship is to be awarded. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA (accumulative) on a 4.0 scale to be eligible.
- The applicant cannot reach their 25th birthday before January 1 of the application year.
- The applicant must be an NJAA member.
- All Angus Foundation undergraduate scholarships must be applied to undergraduate studies only.
- If selected to receive a scholarship by the Angus Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee, the scholarship applicant will be required to verify their enrollment in an institution of higher education by September 15 before the scholarship award check can be issued. Failure to meet enrollment requirements may result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- Should the recipient fail to complete at least one semester of full-time enrollment in an accredited or approved institution of higher education

before June 30, scholarship funds must be refunded to the Angus Foundation.

• Applicants can ONLY receive Angus Foundation general scholarships twice. Application MUST be made each year. Recipients of the \$5,000 scholarships will be ineligible for Angus Foundation general scholarships in subsequent years. Past applicants and recipients of Angus Foundation general scholarships can continue to apply for named scholarships unless otherwise specified by the Angus Foundation. This application applies to the Angus Foundation's general scholarships and named scholarships that the applicant may be eligible to be considered as determined by the Angus Foundation.

Tips for Applying:

For a scholarship application to be considered complete and eligible for review by the Angus Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee, the application MUST:

- Use current year application.
- Include member code of the applicant.
- Must be submitted by May 1 of the application year.
- Include three letters of recommendation (Not from applicants' parents,
 AAA board and/or employees)
- Include a copy of the most recent transcript.
- Receive emailed confirmation your application was received by Angus Foundation Staff.
