

#### 2025 World Angus Forum Youth Team Application

During the World Angus forum countries are invited to create a team of youth to represent their country and compete in different categories. Categories include, but are not limited to:

- Cattle Evaluation
- Cattle Fitting and Showing
- Meat Evaluation
- Public Speaking
- Practical Farming Skills (maintenance, fence building, operating heavy machinery, animal handling)

On behalf of the American Angus Association, we invite Angus youth to apply for the opportunity to represent America at the 2025 World Angus Forum, hosted by Australia. A team of 4 individuals will be selected via the applications. Applicants should be between the ages of 18 – 25 years old (not older than 25 years on day one of the competition or younger than 18).

The American Angus Association is seeking talented, reliable, and outgoing team members. Applicants should have multiple years of experience in the beef industry, and a well-rounded knowledge base parallel to the competition categories listed above.

The World Angus Forum will occur April 28 – May 8, 2025. Additional travel days will be needed before and after the dates of the event. The competition runs in conjunction with the youth tour. Team members will not only participate in the youth competition but tour Australia learning more about the Angus industry while connecting with Angus breeders from all across the world. Registration costs will be covered by the American Angus Association.

**Applications will be due October 4, 2024.** Upon review, applicants will be notified if they have been accepted or denied. Additional interviews and tasks may be assigned if accepted. The final team will be announced in December 2024.
